What data do we collect?

Gateshead Carers collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (Name, email address, phone number, etc.)
- Information you decide to tell us about yourself as and when you want to.

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Gateshead Carers with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register online or when you use our services.
- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.
- Have a one to one session with any of our staff
- Share information at any one of our groups or training sessions (i.e. Care to Share, Ready Steady grow etc.)

Gateshead Carers may also receive your data indirectly from the following sources:

- An individual or organisation (e.g. your GP) may refer you to Gateshead Carers. If we receive personal information about you from another organisation we will always check with you that they had your permission to supply us with that information.

How will we use your data?

Our Company collects your data so that we can:

- Provide you with the support you ask for.
- Email or mail out information to you with information about our services and events we think you might like.

If you agree Gateshead Carers will share your data with other services so that they may offer you their products and services.

How do we store your data?

Gateshead Carers securely stores your data at our office (John Haswell House, 8/9 Gladstone terrace Gateshead NE8 4DY. It is stored on Charity log which is our client management system.

Gateshead Carers will keep your personal data for as long as we have an association with you in the form of sending you our newsletter or any information about our groups or activities or you continue to have a one to one or group support from us, unless you tell us to do otherwise. We do this because carers frequently come back to us for further support and we do not want to ask you for the same information every time you contact us.

Once you inform us that you do not want us to keep your data we will delete your data by removing all your personal data from Charity log subject to legal requirements. For example if you have had a grant through us we are legally required to keep your data for a period of 8 years. We will ofcourse not send you any marketing or other relevant information.

### Marketing

Gateshead Carers would like to send you information about products and services of ours that we think you might like.

If you have agreed to receive marketing, you may always opt out at a later date.

You have the right at any time to stop Our Company from contacting you for marketing purposes or giving your data to other members of the Our Company Group.

If you no longer wish to be contacted for marketing purposes, please inform us about it

What are your data protection rights?

Our Company would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights.

Every user is entitled to the following:

**The right to access** - You have the right to request Gateshead Carers for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

**The right to rectification** - You have the right to request that Gateshead Carers correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request us to complete information you believe is incomplete.

**The right to erasure** - You have the right to request that Gateshead Carers erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

**The right to restrict processing** - You have the right to request that Gateshead Carers restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

**The right to object to processing** - You have the right to object to Gateshead Carers processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

**The right to data portability** - You have the right to request that Gateshead Carers transfer the data that we have collected to another organisation, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
